Additional topics discussed:



A discussion was held regarding 2019 BMOC funding. Head Trustee DiGuglielmo mentioned that the apparatus apron may need to be replaced, based on input from a vendor who pressure washed the concrete last year. Evans suggested we consult with Cousin's Concrete for an opinion, as they are a reputable company and do a lot of work for the township. DiGuglielmo agreed to follow up with them.
