

The Board of Fire Commissioners, District #2, Gloucester Township, held a Workshop in the Chews Landing Fire Station on Tuesday, October 6, 2020 at 7:30 pm.

Chairman Genzel opened the meeting at 7:33 pm with the flag salute and acknowledgement of the meeting being held in accordance with the Open Public Meeting Act.

Also present was Administrator Robb and Chief Millisky.

The Commissioners discussed the topics listed on the attached agenda prepared by Administrator Robb.

Commissioner Grady expressed his opinion that the Social Networking and Digital Imaging policies to be adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners should apply only to the career staff, and that it should be up to the fire company to adopt policies pertaining to their members. Discussion followed with acknowledgement that the policies affect all aspects of the organization and it would not be practical to have separate policies. It was also noted that fire company members were given the opportunity to comment on the policy and that edits were made to accommodate some of their concerns. It was also noted that Chief Millisky and President Koehler are in favor of the policy and agree that it should be adopted. At the conclusion of the conversation Commissioner Grady he agrees that the Board should adopt the policies but feels the fire company should endorse them.

The commissioners then worked on the 2021 budget. Commissioner Grady suggested consideration be given to a 2% raise for the commissioners. Chairman Genzel said he was not in favor of increasing the stipends at this time.
